Good afternoon Diaz,

In the recent CoC 2019 competition, The Eddy House was eligible to apply for \$31,584 for your Ridgehouse RRH project. I was informed that your organization was **voluntarily reallocating** your funds due to a recent change in Directors at the Eddy House, the challenges with finding housing for transition aged youth, and your ongoing fund development efforts to support operating funds for your new facility. Thank you for letting the Rating and Ranking committee know that you were voluntarily reallocating your funds. As such, your funding has been reallocated to Washoe County. That will not affect this year's funding and the current grant you are operating but you will not be eligible for renewal when your current grant expires.

The Rating and Ranking committee met on September 5, 2019, to review applications and all of the supporting materials included in submissions. The Rating and Ranking Committee in their deliberations reviewed all materials and performance for the projects. The Rating and Ranking Committee determined that they would reallocate your funds to Washoe County in the full amount as described above.

Thank you for submitting an application for Northern Nevada Adult Mental Health Services Shelter plus Care project for the 2019 CoC competition. for the 2019 CoC Funding Competition.

The Rating and Ranking committee met on September 5, 2019, to review your application and all of the supporting materials included in your submission. The Rating and Ranking Committee reviewed all of your materials and performance for the project. Your application received a weighted score of 78 out of 100 possible points. The Rating and Ranking Committee determined the ranked number 9 in tier 1. However, because of your expenditure rate and a desire to ensure other projects were fully funded per CoC priorities, they re-allocated \$22,032. Good afternoon Julianna,

Thank you for submitting applications for the Volunteers of America Anchor and Anchor Expansion and Rapid Re-housing for Families projects for the 2019 CoC competition. The Rating and Ranking committee met on September 5, 2019, to review your applications and all of the supporting materials included in your submissions. In their deliberations, the Rating and Ranking Committee reviewed all of your documents and performance for the projects.

The Rating and Ranking Committee determined that the Anchor and Anchor Expansion would be ranked number 6 in tier 1 with a weighted score of 85 out of 100 points possible. The Rapid Re-Housing for Families project is ranked number 7 in tier 1 with a weighted score of 85 out of 100 points possible as well.

Rapid Re-Housing for Families was fully funded at the requested amount of \$87,659.

However, to ensure other projects were fully funded per CoC priorities, they re-allocated \$93,568 from Anchor and Anchor Expansion. This was largely based on the reported expenditure rate from the previous year. Therefore, the funding recommendation for Anchor and Anchor Expansion is for \$703,235. The final Rating and Ranking results are attached for your review.

Thank you for submitting applications for Washoe County Permanent Supportive Housing Renewal, Rapid Re-Housing TAY, Shelter Plus Care 1, and Permanent Supportive housing 2 project applications.

The Rating and Ranking committee met on September 5, 2019, to review your applications and all of the supporting materials included in your submissions. The Rating and Ranking Committee in their deliberations reviewed all of your materials and performance for each of the projects.

Your application for Rapid Re-Housing TAY received a weighted score of 88 out of 100 possible points. The Rating and Ranking Committee determined that the Rapid Re-Housing TAY would be ranked number 4 in tier 1. Rapid Re-Housing TAY was fully funded at the requested amount of \$31,584.

Your application for Shelter Plus Care 1 received a weighted score of 88 out of 100 possible points. The Rating and Ranking Committee determined that the Shelter Plus Care 1 would be ranked number 5 in tier 1. The Shelter Plus Care 1 project was fully funded at the requested amount of \$119,616.

Your application for Permanent Supportive Housing Renewal received a weighted score of 79 out of 100 possible points. The Rating and Ranking Committee determined that the Shelter Plus Care would be ranked number 8 in tier 1. The Permanent Supportive Housing Renewal was fully funded at the requested amount of \$86,328.

Your new application for Permanent Supportive Housing 2 received a weighted score of 96 out of 100 possible points. The Rating and Ranking Committee determined that the Shelter Plus Care would be ranked number 11 in tier 2. While the application was extremely well written, the Rating and Ranking Committee was not able to identify funding that would place Permanent Supportive Housing 2 in tier 1. However, the project was fully funded at the requested amount of \$97,034.
