

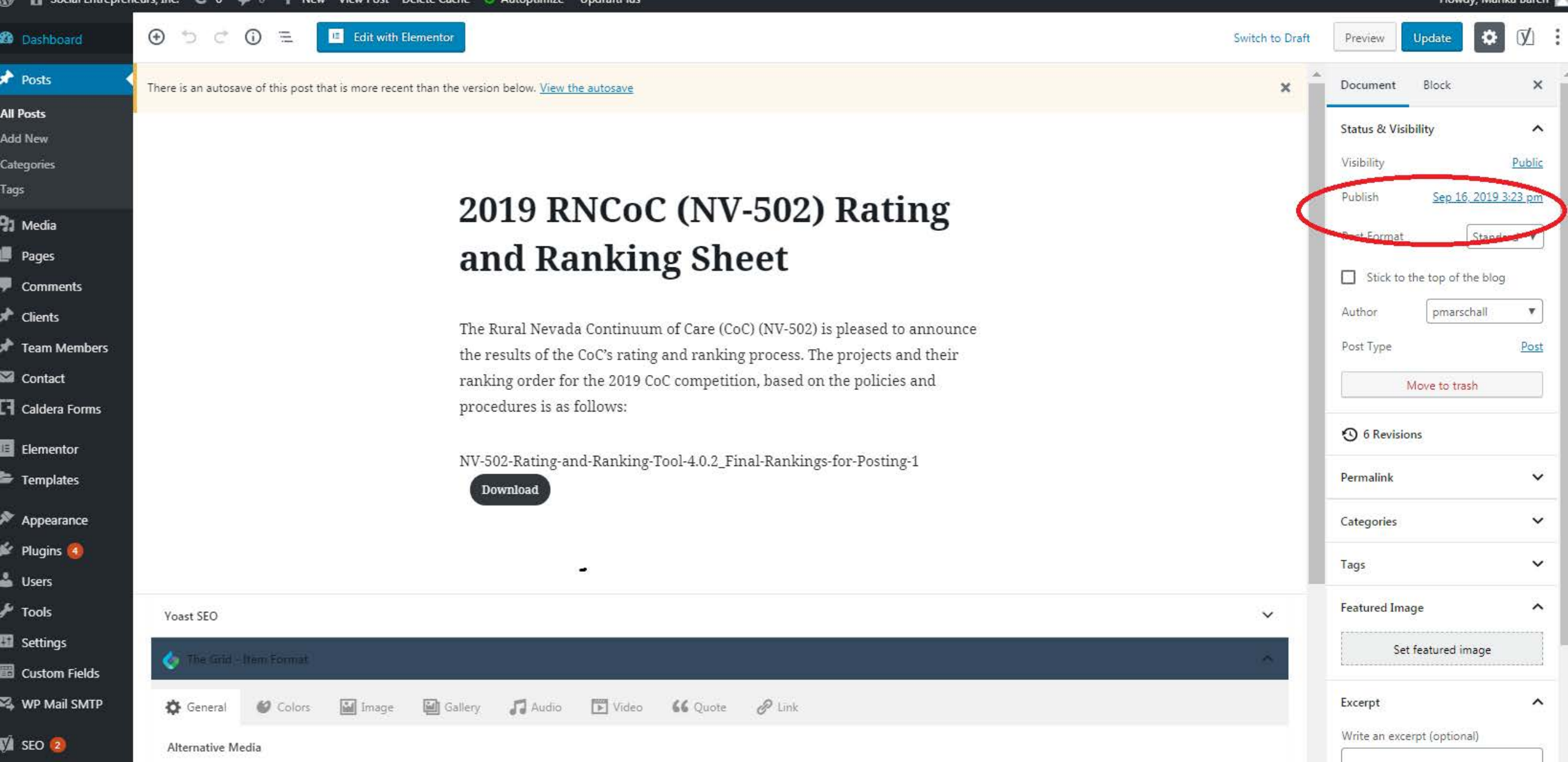


2019 RNCoc (NV-502) Rating and Ranking Sheet
